The Customer and Nordea have entered into an e-Markets Customer Contract together with General Terms and Conditions for e-Markets (the "Agreement"). Any term not defined in this power of attorney shall have the meaning set out in the Agreement. The Customer acknowledges that it has informed the Administrator of the Agreement. Furthermore, the Customer acknowledges that it is solely responsible for informing the Administrator of any amendments to the Agreement.

Administrator authority

The Customer hereby appoints the Administrator by way of a power of attorney, with reference to Clause 6 in the General Terms and Conditions for e-Markets, as Administrator of e-Markets.

The Customer hereby authorises the Administrator to represent the Customer in and in relation to e-Markets in administrative matters including, but not limited to, to appoint and authorise Users of e-Markets.

The right to authorize Users may be exercised by the Administrator alone unless the checkbox for "Jointly" has been marked upon which the authority may only be exercised by the Administrator together with another Administrator.

Jointly

Irrespective of whether the authority to authorize a User is given to an Administrator alone or jointly with another Administrator, each Administrator is always entitled to cancel a power of attorney given to a User.

The Administrator may authorise itself to be a User and manage its own User authority.

User authority

If any of the below checkboxes has been checked, the Customer hereby appoints the above-defined Administrator as a User of e-Markets by way of a power of attorney in accordance with the below. The Administrator may subsequently change his own authority.

The Administrator is hereby authorised, via e-Markets or otherwise in connection with the use of e-Markets, to act as a User on the Customer's and any Participating Entity's behalf in relation to any Nordea Company or any Service Provider according to the following:

- To **view** information relating to the Customer and any Participating Entity (e.g. customer classification, reports and other documents)
- To **view** information relating to the Transactions of the Customer and any Participating Entity
- To **confirm** receipt of, give and alter information relating to the Customer and any Participating Entity (e.g. in relation to customer classification and Know Your Customer procedures or in relation to the receipt of product and risk descriptions)

- To **confirm** Transactions electronically
 - Jointly (if selected, the authority may only be exercised together with another User with this authority)

- To **trade** in e-Markets (i.e. enter into Transactions)

- To **enter into agreements** electronically regarding services offered by the Nordea Group or any other Service Provider (other than Transactions) including agreeing to amendments to the Agreement
 - Jointly (if selected, the authority may only be exercised together with another User with this authority)

This power of attorney is governed by the laws of the country set out in the e-Markets Customer Contract and the courts set out therein shall have jurisdiction also in relation to this power of attorney.

This power of attorney replaces any previously issued power of attorney in relation to e-Markets for the Administrator and is valid until revoked by notice to Nordea (in written form or in accordance with a procedure for revocation in e-Markets) or replaced by a new power of attorney in relation to the Administrator.
